#### Dredging

**Mariners are hereby advised** that subject to the weather, dredging works are expected to begin on Saturday 02/03/19 within the Wyre Dock Marina Fairway and in the entrance to B section of the Marina for a period of time.

The grab dredger 'Admiral Day' will be engaged in these operations at various places and the vessel will display lights and shapes as required by the International Regulations for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea. Mariners should expect to encounter this vessel working at any time and at any position between the Wyre Marina and the Lune Deep disposal site.

Whilst the Admiral Day is operating in the Marina Fairway, it is possible that this channel may not be accessible to other users. Vessels wishing to pass the dredger should contact them on VHF ch 12.

The dredger should be given as wide a berth as possible at all times as she may be constrained by their draught.

The dredger will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 12 throughout their operations.

Mariners may also request dredger movement information from "Fleetwood Dock Radio" also on VHF Channel 12 during lock opening times.

A further notice will be issued upon completion of works.
